### POLICE REPORTS BY WATCH AREA

#### **Business/Industrial WATCH AREA:**

##### **Unlawful Acquisition of a Controlled Substance**

**Arrest, (03/01):** 16 E. Lake Street, Miriam Taylor took blank prescriptions from a prescription pad at a doctor's office where she used to work and made them out for Methylphenibate where she tried to have the prescription filled at Walgreen's.

**Domestic Battery Arrest, (03/17):** 1155 N. Swift Road, Patrick Sikora, while attending a fundraiser for Children's Cancer at Dave & Buster's, became combative with his girlfriend striking her in the head with his fist.

**Unlawful Possession of Cannabis, Warrant Service Arrest, (03/14):** 437 S. Addison Road, Scott Maney was seen loitering around JD Muggs after closing hours, where he was stopped and found to be wanted on 2 Failure To Appear warrants. Also, when searched was found to have a quantity of Cannabis in his possession.
